The Pacific Region Infrastructure Facility (PRIF) is inviting you to **PRIF Week 2022**, a virtual conference to be held every day over five days from 17 to 21 October 2022. The event intends to bring together infrastructure practitioners and experts, including government officials, development partners, regional organizations, academia, and the private sector.

The objectives of PRIF Week 2022 are to:

1. Provide a platform for Pacific contractors, governments, development partners, international contractors and others to discuss the opportunities for improving local participation in infrastructure development in the post COVID-19 economic recovery;
2. Enhance awareness of emerging infrastructure priorities and publicly available pipelines of upcoming work for contractors in the Pacific;
3. Provide visibility of local contractors working in infrastructure in PRIF member countries; and
4. Facilitate networking opportunities

PRIF Week 2022 will be held over five half-days from 17 to 21 October 2022 and will include:

- Sharing of information about upcoming infrastructure projects and project profiles by developing partners and Pacific Island country governments
- Virtual exhibition stands by local and international contractors active in the region
- Presentations and deep dive discussions into infrastructure sector issues
- Information sessions on project procurement for local contractors.

The PRIF Week Virtual Exhibition will be a joint effort of PRIF in partnership with the national Chambers of Commerce in the Pacific. Our aspiration for the Exhibition is to provide contractors with a unique opportunity to promote their services, increase visibility and exposure to national and international infrastructure markets, network with potential business partners, access emerging infrastructure pipelines in the country and across the region, develop promotional documents and learn of contracting opportunities and procurement practices of development partners.

The Virtual Exhibition will be live every day from 1.30pm to 2.30pm Sydney time. Participants can visit the virtual stands to learn about local contractors, international contractors, development partners, to organise one-on-one meetings, and chat live with attending representatives.
